#### • Admin. Concerns:

- O Follow-up regarding Marv's concern over the Centurytel bill: we are on a 'Business Assist Advantage' account which is a bundle where we pay a basic monthly fee with the services provided in that fee no matter how frequent or infrequent the use of them.
