Larry said he didn't move out here for the insurance rates. He also said that Ron should prepare to defend the station staying open and to bring help. Discussed if we are independent enough to take SCFD9 off our first page. Larry thought we should try to get some kids on for summer time help only. Ron said that SCFD10 has a program for that but they are only used in a support role. Ron thinks maybe we should have three volunteers sign up for weekends and those people would be home and ready to go. Ron will implement this idea.
