Instructions to Bidders

The Board of Commissioners of Spokane County Fire District 5 had declared two (2) vehicles, one (1) Fire suppression equipment and one (1) accessory to the needs of the District at their January 14, 2025, regular meeting. A description of the surplus vehicles is attached.

Invitation to Bid on Surplus Vehicles

1. Sealed bids will be received by Spokane County Fire District 5 until 5:00 p.m. on January 31, 2025, by District Secretary Bethany McCann at 17217 W Four Mound Rd Nine Mile Falls WA 99026, for the purchase of surplus vehicles.
2. The surplus vehicles are detailed on the attached list and may be inspected by prospective bidders prior to bidding. Appointments for inspection are to be made with **Chief Scott Lynch by calling 509-979-4606** between 8:00-5:00, Monday-Friday.
3. Bids must be submitted on the form provided by the District. All parts of the form are to be completed.
4. See the attached list for the stated minimum bid amount for the surplus vehicles.
5. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope which is plainly marked with "*Bid for Surplus Vehicle*" and addressed to:

6. Sealed bids will be opened and presented to the Board of Commissioners at their regular meeting on Tuesday, February 11, 2025 at 6:00 p.m.
7. The board of Commissions of the District reserves the right to waive informality and irregularity in the bids and accept or reject and or all bids.
8. Bidders will be notified of the bid award within fourteen (14) days of bid opening, unless the Board of Commissioners defers the bid award, in which event notice will be given to bidders. Acceptance of a bid award shall constitute a confirmed and completed sale of the subject vehicle to the bidder, who then becomes the purchaser. The purchaser shall be immediately vested with ownership of the vehicle upon receipt of payment, at which point Fire District 5 shall have no further interest in or liability for it.
9. Purchasers will be invoiced for the full amount due for the surplus vehicle/s awarded on their bid/s. Full payment to Spokane County Fire District 5 shall be due and payable at the time of invoice, and must be received by the District within thirty (30) days of invoice date unless other terms for payment have been approved by the Fire Chief.
10. The vehicle/s will be available to the purchaser at Station 51, at a time to be arranged between the purchaser and the District Chief after the acceptance to the bid Proof of purchase (SCFD5 receipt) must be shown prior to taking delivery of purchased property.
11. All surplus vehicles are sold "as is, where is" without a warranty of any kind, and without any statement of implication of condition, fitness for purpose or service life.
12. Purchaser of any surplus vehicle assumes full liability for its condition and use and by placement of a bid, agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Spokane County Fire District 5 from any liabilities or cost whatsoever arising out of the purchase or use of any surplus vehicle.
13. The submittal of a bid shall constitute acceptance of these *Instructions to Bidders*.
